**Supplier Confirmation in Accordance with Article 5(4) and (5) of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR) -
*Packaging***

We confirm that the *packaging supplied by us for product protection* complies with the requirements of Article 5(4) and (5) of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR).

- Heavy metals (Article 5(4)):
The sum of the concentrations of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium present in packaging or packaging components does not exceed 100 mg/kg.
- PFAS (Article 5(5)):
The packaging materials were developed and manufactured without the intentional use of PFAS. PFAS are not added during the intended subsequent processing of packaging paper products. Packaging components that are in direct contact with food-contact papers comply with applicable food law and Article 5(5) of the PPWR. For most other packaging components, compliance with Article 5(5) of the PPWR has been confirmed by the packaging material suppliers. For some packaging materials, no such analyses regarding PFAS are available, because these materials are not intended for direct contact with food. Furthermore, the requirements of Article 5(5) of the PPWR apply only to packaging that comes into contact with food.
